Meso level narrative data

- Meso level NPF research focuses on policy narratives from policy actors
- who are the relevant policy actors?
- Where / how do they communicate with the public?

Relevant actors

- Our assumption: An official (governmental) narrative and other narrative(s) countering official narrative
- The NPF separates actors into discourse coalitions: define the side of the debate according to policy positions (for or against a policy)

Relevant actors

Official narrative

- Moscow government and administration
- United Russia party members
- [Official media]



Counter narrative

- Non-systemic opposition members
- Systemic opposition members?
- NGOs
- Activist groups
- [Independent media]

Policy positions

For <i>renovatsia</i>	Against (this version) of <i>renovatsia</i>
For public transport reforms	Against (this version) of public transport reform
Solve the garbage crisis For increasing recycling, reducing garbage	Keep status quo For landfills, garbage storage

Scope

- Open questions:
 - What is our timeframe?
 - Governance level: do we only include Moscow city, Moscow oblast, or the federal level?
 - Only public debates or also closed debates?

Timeframe

- Most studies examine policy narrative over the known length of the policy debate
 - Sobyenin mayor since 2010
 - Start waste crisis ???
 - Start renovation program ???
 - New transport policy since ???

Governance level

Preference to work at the level of Moscow city only.

- For renovation: ok?
- For transport: ok? need to include oblast?
- Waste management: ?

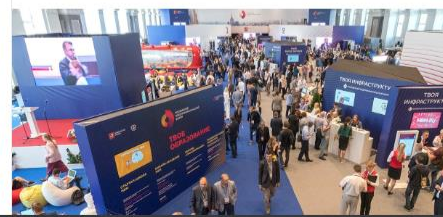

Potential data sources

- Websites of NGOs
 - What would be the most relevant NGOs for your cases?

Potential data sources

- **Social media** (for both sides of the debate)
 - Facebook
 - Vkontakte
 - Telegramm
 - Twitter
- Should we mix social media and other (online) sources?

Potential data sources

- Media (available online):
 - “Official” media
 - E.g., moskva24
 - Independent media
 - Ekho moskvii
 - medusa

Potential data sources

- What about:
 - Public speeches?
 - Debates in gorodskaya дума?
- Should we include only text or also video?

What text from what source did you
bring today?

In groups: make a list of the most important sources of narrative data for your case

Include both sides of the debate.

Put most important sources first.

Collection procedures

- We collect all data on the debates
 - In our timeframe from the selected sources
 - Afterwards we might have to exclude some text, if they are not a policy narrative (= do not contain a character)
- We start collecting with the most relevant sources

Who searches what?

Collection procedures

- We save all texts on google drive / drop box. One folder per case. You need to copy text or make a print screen into a world file
- We name the files in a folder according to certain rules
- We add each text in an excel file

How to name a file

1. Letter for your case

- R = Renovatsia
- T = Transport
- W = Waste management

2. Number the documents

3. Your initials (First name, last name)

- R1CS, R2CS..., T1CS
- R1KZ, R2KZ...
